Title I/School Improvement Summary

Decrease the number of students not making AYP in Language Arts by 10% each year. The following action steps will be implemented:

- Weekly teacher PLC meetings
- Dedicated 3 hours of effective literacy instruction
- 30 minutes Tier II interventions
- Increased family literacy opportunities

Decrease the number of students not making AYP in Math by 10% each year. The following action steps will be implemented:

- Weekly teacher PLC meetings
- Dedicated 90 minutes of effective math instruction
- Math achievement assessment every 3 weeks
- Targeted math interventions
- Increased communication between home and school

Decrease major and minor behavior referrals by 10% each year. The following action steps will be implemented:

- Increase attendance to 93% average daily attendance
- Provide a system of support for families in need of coordinated health and community services.
