Minutes from SCC meeting on May 4, 2010 were approved by unanimous vote.

- Kelli gave an update on our T-shirt sales. Want this T-shirt to be the Fun Run shirt. Looking at in the future the possibility of having Student Council sell the shirts on Fridays. Add a display of one of the shirts in the office and have forms available or actual T-shirts available (Mona assigned to this). If we do this once a month, perhaps the office staff would be willing to do this.

- Nancy Trust Lands update.

We reviewed these 2009-2010 scores: GRL (Guided Reading Levels), PALS (Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening), SRI (Scholastic Reading Inventory), and CRT's (Criterion Reference Test) (primary indicator used to measure progress for AYP).

YES! We made AYP and met our Trust Lands goal.

Our money allocated for last year to provide Professional Development opportunities for our teachers was a plus in helping to make ATP.

This year the school is adding "REACH" (30 minutes each day). Skill-based to enrich, re-teach or provide intervention for students at their own level.

When Nancy receives the finalized Trust Lands report, we will need to come in and sign the signature page (probably sometime in October).

- The Jordan District delay--an RFP (Request for Pricing) on the Waterford program] was completed last week, and as soon as Nancy receives the final report/recommendation we can proceed with ordering the software (school purchase) and the computers (SCC purchase) that we allocated money for.

- Bird waste issue: A power-washer has been purchased, and Morris (custodian) is using this to keep the entry ways cleaned as much as possible. There is improvement, but this will be a continuing issue.

- School is working to purchase an electronic marquee using Stimulus money. This sign will most likely be mounted to the school building to lessen the likelihood of vandalism.

- Jimmy Anderson was nominated by Kathy/seconded by Randy to serve as the 2010-2011 Chairperson and received unanimous vote in favor (Jimmy abstained from voting.).

- Mona declined nomination for Vice-Chair.

- Denise Dorado Favela was nominated by Mona/seconded by Randy to serve as the 2010-2011 Vice-Chairperson and received unanimous vote in favor.
